


PROFILE HEMMAT SHABAB FOUNDATION FOR DEVELOPMENT




Global Hand washing Day campaign

The Global Handwashing Day campaign aimed to strengthen and support the hand-washing culture among school students, health workers and camp residents in five governorates to reduce the increasing number of infectious diseases.




WASH interventions To Combat the Cholera Epidemic

- **188** community volunteers trained on Cholera response (**60%** female)
- **55,179** Households benefited from the hygiene promotion sessions on Cholera at HH level.
- **20,000** BHKs distributed in Taiz.
- Rapid needs WASH Assessment conducted by **82** community volunteers (**65%** female).
- Rehabilitate the sewer network with **581**-meter length l.
- Rehabilitate **7** water wells by constructing a barrier wall, covering and sterilizing it.
- Rehabilitate toilets for **12** Health centres.
- Solid waste collection campaigns for Taiz city **18296** Cubic meters.

• The rehabilitation of the latrines of (39) schools in five districts in Taiz governorate, a number of (28902) students has benefited.

• (450) chairs were repaired in (15) schools.


• (15944) school bags were distributed to students of Grade One in (257) schools in six districts in Taiz governorate.

• (200) teachers of the Grade One had a training in skills of psychosocial support.


• (200) teachers and educational mentors had a training in skills of conducting active learning strategies.
